Standardize and simplify processes

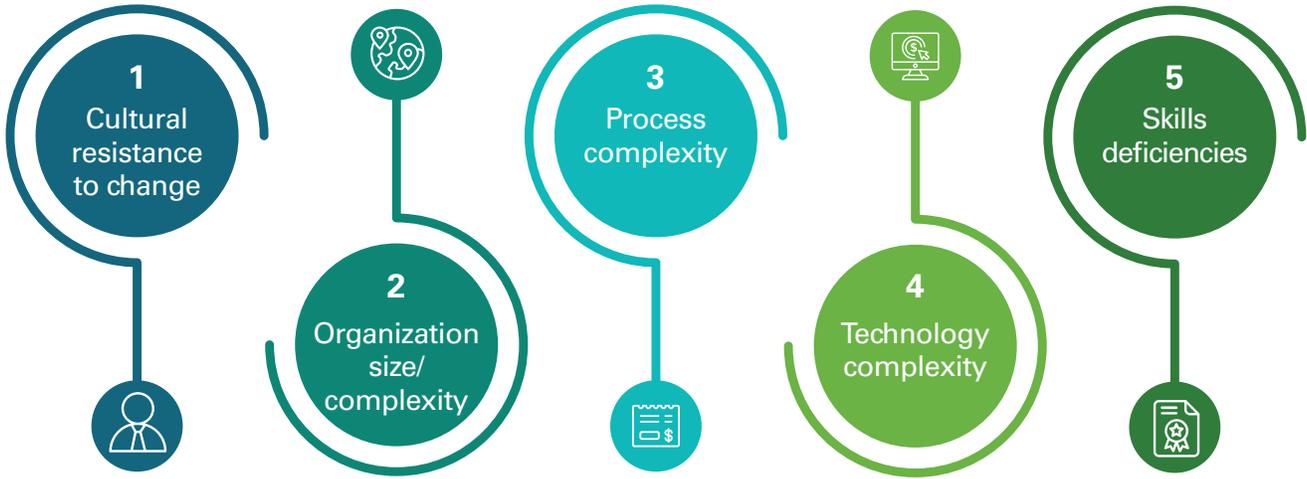
Migrate applications to the cloud.

WHERE TO START?

- 1 Use existing business-partnering relations and other lines of communication with the business (or establish new ones) to strengthen the dialogue.
- 2 Through these channels and partnerships, improve procurement's understanding of the importance of the enterprise's ability to respond to specific types of business events and disruptors.
- 3 Analyze the dependencies of enterprise agility needs on procurement capabilities (e.g., provide critical data and analysis).
- 4 Assess the effectiveness of any agility-enhancing practices that have already been adopted.
- 5 Analyze the suitability for adoption of practices considered highly effective by external sources (e.g., industry peers, external research, consultancies).
- 6 Develop a roadmap specifying which practices will be adopted, fine-tuned, accelerated or sustained.
- 7 Establish a strong change-management program, since the most significant inhibitor of increased agility is human resistance to change.
